
AmeriCorps VISTA Program Models

Single Site Model

- Supervisor
- VISTA Member(s)

Intermediary Model

- VISTA sub-sites are in the state; may include sites in another state or cluster
- Sub-site supervisors
- VISTA members(s)





Responsibilities: Project Management



Obtain Community input - work with, not just for the target population(s)



Performance measures – the results through outputs and outcomes



Reporting

- Project Progress Reports (PPRs) two a year
- VISTA Progress Report Supplement (VPRS) annual, due mid November

Cost Sharing

- Affordable ways to increase the number of AmeriCorps
 VISTA members
- Demonstrates that sponsors are invested in the VISTA project's success
- Help expand VISTA Resources across the country

AmeriCorps VISTA + HUD

• 200+VISTA members will be mobilized to enroll HUD-assisted families for Child Tax Credit (Promise Zones, Envisions Centers and more).



AmeriCorps Senior + Head Start

 AmeriCorps Seniors volunteers will be able to serve onsite at designated Head Start centers in 16 targeted cities to help non-fliers sign up.



AmeriCorps VISTA: Program Flexibility



AmeriCorps VISTA has permitted program flexibility to include CTC activities

- In effect: September 13 November 15
- Impacts 4,000+ full-time VISTA members
- Activities may include outreach, education, and direct enrollment of eligible individuals for this tax credit



AmeriCorps VISTA Members

The Basics

- 18+ years of age
- U.S. citizens or legal permanent residents
- Must pass a criminal history review
- May have specific knowledge skills, or abilities as required by the sponsoring organization
- Local or national recruits





<u>Create Powerful Partnerships</u> with businesses, community leaders, and other stakeholders



Expand current programs in demographic, geographic, and/or programmatic scope

<u>Build</u> volunteer management, leadership and training systems


Leverage both cash and in-kind resources by building development systems

- Am eriCorps VISTA Concept Paper
 Organizations submit an AmeriCorps VISTA
 Concept Paper. The Concept Paper is a
 preliminary screening tool used to evaluate
 whether the organization would be an appropriate
 sponsor.
- Am eriCorps VISTA Project Application

 If approved, the organization submits an

 AmeriCorps VISTA Project Application based on
 the approved Concept Paper.



- Aligns with AmeriCorps focus areas/VISTA programming priorities
- Addresses the needs of a low -income community
- Involves the community in project development and implementation
- Leads to organizational capacity and sustainability
- Generates public or private sector resources
- Promotes local volunteer service
- Be specific about intention tactics

Completing the Application Process



Submit a Full VISTA Application: If your organization's concept paper is accepted, your AmeriCorps Regional Office will notify you and request that you submit a full application.



Supervisor Orientation: AmeriCorps will provide a virtual orientation.



Member Recruitment: The sponsoring organization will develop a Service Opportunity Listing on eGrants to recruit VISTA candidates.
